

Starting a scheme is a very important decision for a person to take, it means that they want to be active in their community and make a difference, by making it a stronger, safer and more resilient place to live. Achieving this by being more neighbourly, looking out for each other and taking positive action to reduce crime and the fear of



The person that starts a scheme is called a coordinator and they act as a contact for the local policing team and NW Association and pass this information on to their members' neighbours. Being as proactive as possible makes a huge difference in connecting

A Force Association supports and approves schemes and members across their region and provide essential resources, such as support, signage, stickers and training, provide links to contacts from partner, and act as the main support of Neighbourhood Watch on a localised





Having a positive voice in our community makes a difference. Join in or start proactive activities to improve your community, such as litter picking, this helps reduce anti-social behaviour when a community looks after its look. Connecting with your local policing team to keep up to date with activities and campaigns is great so that you can get your neighbourhood involved


