### How to enter

1. Create your cartoon using the posters and postcard templates provided on [www.ourwatch.org.uk/letstayconnected](http://www.ourwatch.org.uk/letstayconnected), or on a blank piece of paper
2. Take a photo of or scan in your cartoon
3. Email it to [enquiries@ourwatch.org.uk](mailto:enquiries@ourwatch.org.uk) with your name, Borough or County you live in,, and age category (4 – 11 years, 12 – 17 years, or Adult)
4. Share your cartoon on social media with #LetsStayConnected, tagging Neighbourhood Watch (@ourwatch for Facebook, @N\_watch for Twitter) Instagram!! Perfect opportunity to use it here
5. Gift your cartoon as a thank you poster or postcard to a neighbour
6. We will notify the winner of each category by 30<sup>th</sup> June via email and ask for the best delivery address

### Rules

1. Competition runs from 7<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> June
2. Entries are limited to residents of England and Wales
3. Winners for each category will be announced by 30<sup>th</sup> June
4. Winners will be judged on by Tony Husband and the decision will be final
5. No offensive language or visuals permitted
6. Unfortunately, we cannot accept posted entries for this competition
